

# COMPETITION RULES

Children's Run  
STARKIDS EGYPT 2026

## 1. General Information about the Competition

1.1. The **STARKIDS EGYPT 2026** children's run (hereinafter – the Competition) is held within the framework of the **IRONSTAR EGYPT 2026 Sports Festival**.

1.2. The Competition aims to promote a healthy lifestyle among children and to encourage regular physical activity and sports participation.

1.3. Distances:

- **0.5 km** – children up to **7 years** old;
- **1 km** – children from **7 to 12 years** inclusive.

1.4. Date and start time: **January 30, 2026**.

1.5. Venue: **Nabq Bay, Sharm El Sheikh 2, South Sinai Governorate, Egypt**.

## 2. Management

2.1. The Competition is organized and conducted by **Architecture of Sports LLC (Russia)** and **Powerridesports (Power Ride for Sports Services) (Egypt)** (hereinafter – the Co-organizer) together with the Chief Referee Panel (hereinafter – the Organizing Committee).

2.2. The composition of the Chief Referee Panel is approved by **Architecture of Sports LLC** and the Co-organizer.

## 3. Participant Requirements and Admission Conditions

3.1. Admission to participation:

- Children **up to 12 years old inclusive** are allowed to participate.
- The participant's age is determined as of **December 31** of the competition year.
- When collecting the race pack, the child's **parent or legal guardian** must sign a consent form allowing the child to participate in the Competition.
- The Organizers reserve the right to refuse registration if there are reasonable doubts that the participant is physically capable of completing the distance, if participation poses a threat to the participant's life or health, or if participation could harm the image of the Competition. In such cases, the registrant will receive an explanation by email. If the entry fee had already been paid, it will be refunded in full.

3.2. Race pack collection:

- The **parent or guardian** must personally collect the child's race pack.

3.3. Race packs are issued only upon:

- Presentation of identification documents for the **parent/guardian and the child**.

3.4. Participants in sports events organized by **Architecture of Sports LLC** may form teams. Teams may create a name, motto, or slogan of their choice (provided it does not insult or demean

other participants, spectators, or citizens and does not violate the laws of the Russian Federation or Egypt) and may use such name/motto/slogan for identification. Teams may also create their own symbols, which may be displayed as prints or patches on personal clothing or on team flags. Such symbols must not infringe third-party intellectual property, violate moral standards or applicable laws, or contain offensive or prohibited (including extremist) content under Russian or Egyptian law. If logos or names protected as registered trademarks are used, the team must have the rights holder's consent. Flag displays at the event are permitted in any manner not prohibited by law or the Organizer's rules, provided they do not cover the Organizer's sponsors' and partners' information.

## 4. Participation Information

4.1. Travel, accommodation, and meals are at the expense of the delegating organizations and participants.

4.2. Registration limit: **100**. The Organizers reserve the right to adjust the limit based on venue specifics.

4.3. Participation format:

- **Individual:** the child completes the entire distance independently, or accompanied by a parent or guardian (as specified below).

## 5. Participant Categories

Age groups: **girls and boys up to 12 years old inclusive**.

## 6. Competition Schedule

The current schedule is available at [www.iron-star.com](http://www.iron-star.com). The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make changes.

## 7. Competition Rules

7.1. The Competition is conducted in accordance with these Regulations.

7.2. Children **under 7** may cover the **0.5 km** distance **accompanied by parents**. Children **7 and older** must cover the **1 km** distance **independently**, without parental accompaniment.

## 8. Determination of Winners

Within the STARKIDS children's run, **no winners or prize-winners are determined**. All children who complete their distance are awarded the Competition's commemorative items.

## 9. Awards

All participants who complete the distance receive **finisher medals**.

## 10. Application Procedure (Online Registration)

- 10.1. The parent or guardian (hereinafter – the registrant) must register on the Organizer's website: [www.iron-star.com](http://www.iron-star.com).
- 10.2. A participant is considered registered and is included in the start protocol published on the event page at [www.iron-star.com](http://www.iron-star.com) after the registrant submits the application in accordance with the rules and pays the entry fee.
- 10.3. By registering and paying the entry fee, the registrant consents to the processing of their **own personal data** and the **child's personal data**.
- 10.4. By registering and paying the entry fee, the registrant agrees to these Competition Regulations and confirms that the participant has been informed of the Competition rules.
- 10.5. The registrant is personally responsible for the accuracy of the data provided about themselves and about the participant.
- 10.6. For effective communication, the registrant must provide a correct phone number and email address. All news, changes, and results will be sent to these contacts.
- 10.7. Start lists will be closed to changes **no later than 16 days before** the race.

## 11. Exchange and Refund

- 11.1. Refunds are made to the registrant's personal account balance in the amount of **75% of the slot price**. Funds cannot be withdrawn; they can be used to purchase any slot on [www.iron-star.com](http://www.iron-star.com).
- 11.2. **Transfer of a slot to a third party is not possible.**
- 11.3. All possible operations with slots must be completed **no later than 16 days before** the race.

## 12. Force Majeure

In case of weather or other force-majeure circumstances, the Organizers reserve the right to change the Competition Regulations (postpone the start time, cancel or shorten the **swim** segment) up to and including cancellation of the event, with subsequent notification of participants. In such cases, the entry fee is **non-refundable**.
